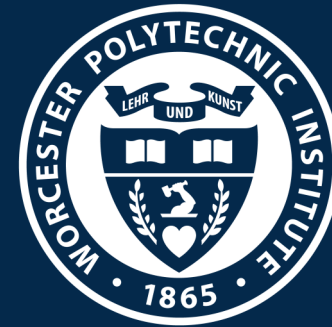

- Write your responses to application prompts
- Solicit two references, including at least one WPI faculty member



COMPLETE APPLICATION

- “Apply Now” on the Global Portal for your first-choice project center (open Monday, Sept 11)
- Complete application components and upload materials
- Ensure that you have completed the site session module for your first-choice center on Canvas
- Submit your application!

Applications will open Monday, September 11!

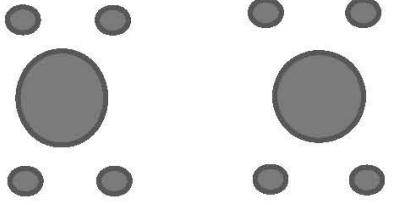
Floor Plan – Rec Center

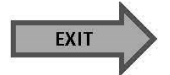
